- 10 branch spread of 44 feet and an age of approximately 40 years; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Keep DeKalb Beautiful and its programs empower local people to take 12 responsibility for preserving and protecting Georgia's natural resources and environment
- 13 and, upon the occasion of this inaugural tree contest, it is abundantly fitting and proper that
