A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide for enforcement of laws governing matters within the jurisdiction of the
- 2 Commissioner of Agriculture or the Department of Agriculture; to provide for certain other
- 3 related law enforcement powers; to amend Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the
- 4 Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to control of infectious or contagious diseases
- 5 in livestock generally, and Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 6 relating to the Department of Agriculture, so as to redesignate and change certain provisions
- 7 relating to enforcement of laws relating to control of infectious or contagious diseases in
- 8 livestock generally; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 SECTION 1.

- 11 Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating
- 12 to control of infectious or contagious diseases in livestock generally, and Chapter 2 of Title
- 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department of Agriculture, are
- 14 amended by redesignating and revising Code Section 4-4-5, relating to enforcement of laws
- relating to control of infectious or contagious diseases in livestock generally, as follows:
- 16 "4-4-5 <u>2-2-13</u>.

- 17 (a) The Commissioner is shall be vested with police powers to enforce this chapter those
- 18 <u>laws governing matters within the jurisdiction of the Commissioner or the department as</u>
- provided by this title and Titles 4, 10, 26, and 43 and the rules and regulations adopted
- 20 pursuant to this chapter thereto and to prevent, detect, and respond to acts of bioterrorism.
- 21 <u>other terroristic acts or threats, or natural disasters affecting or potentially affecting plants,</u>
- 22 <u>animals, products, or facilities that are subject to regulation by the department.</u>
- 23 (b) The Commissioner is shall be authorized to employ, designate, and deputize,
- 24 <u>investigators</u> and <u>to</u> delegate to <u>such</u> employees of the department the necessary authority
- 25 to enforce this chapter those laws governing matters within the jurisdiction of the
- 26 Commissioner or the department as provided by this title and Titles 4, 10, 26, and 43 and

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the rules and regulations adopted pursuant to this chapter thereto and to prevent, detect, and

- 2 respond to acts of bioterrorism, other terroristic acts or threats, or natural disasters affecting
- 3 or potentially affecting plants, animals, products, or facilities that are subject to regulation
- 4 <u>by the department</u>. Employees who have been so designated by the Commissioner and who
- 5 have been certified by the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council as having
- 6 successfully completed the course of training required by Chapter 8 of Title 35, the
- 7 'Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Act,' are shall be authorized:
- 8 (1) To carry firearms authorized or issued by the Commissioner while in the performance
- 9 of their duties;
- 10 (2) To inspect any livestock found within this state <u>plants, animals, products, or facilities</u>
- when the same are subject to regulation by the department;
- 12 (3) To stop and inspect any vehicle transporting livestock in this state; plants, animals,
- or products when the same are subject to regulation by the department;
- 14 (4) To inspect and require the production of health certificates, waybills, permits, or
- other documents required by federal or state laws, rules, regulations, or orders for the
- transportation of livestock plants, animals, or products when the same are subject to
- 17 <u>regulation by the department; and</u>
- 18 (5) To protect any life or property when the circumstances demand action; and
- 19 (5)(6) To arrest any person found to be in violation of this chapter a criminal law when
- 20 <u>enforcement of such law is authorized under this subsection</u>.
- 21 (c) From funds appropriated or available to the department, the Commissioner is shall be
- authorized to provide motor vehicles, uniforms, firearms, and any other equipment and
- supplies needed by employees of the department to carry out this chapter Code section.
- 24 (d) This Code section shall not repeal, supersede, alter, or affect the power of any other
- law enforcement officer of this state or of any county, municipality, or other political
- subdivision of this state to enforce this chapter. At the request of the Commissioner of
- Agriculture, it shall be the duty of all state, county, municipal, and other law enforcement
- officers in this state to enforce and to assist the Commissioner and the employees and
- agents of the department in the enforcement of this chapter those laws governing matters
- 30 within the jurisdiction of the Commissioner or the department as provided by this title and
- 31 Titles 4, 10, 26, and 43."

33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
