A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 17-6-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to where  
2 offenses are bailable, procedure, schedule of bails, and appeal bonds, so as to require certain  
3 trafficking in ecstasy to be bailable only before a superior court judge; to provide for other  
4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 17-6-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to where offenses  
8 are bailable, procedure, schedule of bails, and appeal bonds, is amended by revising  
9 paragraph (10) of subsection (a) to read as follows:  
10 "(10) Violating Code Section 16-13-31, ~~relating to trafficking in cocaine,~~  
11 ~~methamphetamine, or marijuana~~ or Code Section 16-13-31.1;"

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
