A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 3 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to county  
2 and district departments, boards, and directors of family and children services, so as to  
3 provide for the outsourcing of certain duties; to provide for related matters; to repeal  
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 3 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to county and  
8 district departments, boards, and directors of family and children services, is amended by  
9 revising Code Section 49-3-5, relating to powers and duties of county director, as follows:  
10 "49-3-5.

11 The county director shall be the executive and administrative officer of the county  
12 department, shall be responsible for operations and personnel, and shall serve as the  
13 secretary of the county board. He or she shall prepare and submit to the county board for  
14 its approval an annual budget of all funds necessary for the county department. He or she  
15 shall prepare annually a full report of the operations and administration of the county  
16 department. The county director shall be authorized to identify the administrative needs  
17 of his or her office, and, if necessary and appropriate, he or she may outsource such  
18 administrative needs to qualified volunteers. A criminal background check shall be  
19 required for such volunteers at the expense of the volunteer."

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
