## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the emergency medical services professionals of Georgia and recognizing  
2 Thursday, February 18, 2010, as "Emergency Medical Services Recognition Day"; and for  
3 other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the emergency medical services (EMS) professionals of Georgia respond to  
5 almost one million calls for assistance annually, risking their lives on a daily basis to go to  
6 the aid of those in need; and

7 WHEREAS, in the State of Georgia, there are over 14,000 emergency medical services  
8 personnel that provide the essential lifesaving services associated with out-of-hospital  
9 emergency medical care; and

10 WHEREAS, the goals and services of each of these individuals include illness and injury  
11 prevention; trauma system development; public information and education; the prompt,  
12 efficient, and effective delivery of prehospital emergency medical care; transportation to the  
13 most appropriate receiving facility; and other activities related to the health and well-being  
14 of the citizens of Georgia; and

15 WHEREAS, emergency medical services personnel provide access to quality prehospital  
16 emergency care that dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of persons stricken  
17 with sudden illness or injury; and

18 WHEREAS, Georgia's emergency medical services system is celebrating its thirty-seventh  
19 year of service in 2010; and

20 WHEREAS, Thursday, February 18, 2010, is "Emergency Medical Services Recognition  
21 Day" in Georgia, and it is fitting and proper that the emergency medical services  
22 professionals of Georgia be recognized for their outstanding and courageous service.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
24 the members of this body commend the emergency medical services professionals of Georgia  
25 for their outstanding service to this state and recognize Thursday, February 18, 2010, as  
26 "Emergency Medical Services Recognition Day" at the state capitol.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
28 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Courtney Terwilliger,  
29 Chairman of the Georgia Association of Emergency Medical Services, and Billy Watson,  
30 Acting Director of the Georgia Office of Emergency Medical Services and Trauma of the  
31 Department of Human Resources, Division of Public Health.
