## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending American Legion Post 143 on the occasion of its 75th  
2 anniversary; and for other purposes.

4 of World War I had a vision to support their community; and

10 promoting a strong national security, and demonstrating a continued devotion to their fellow  
11 service members and veterans; and
