A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-2-152 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees
- 2 for apportionable vehicles, so as to provide for the payment of an ad valorem fee payable at
- 3 the time of payment of the annual fee for such vehicles; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 40-2-152 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees for
8	apportionable vehicles, is revised to read as follows:
9	"40-2-152.
10	(a) Except as otherwise provided for in this Code section, the annual fee for all
11	apportionable vehicles not operated as a common or contract carrier for hire in accordance
12	with owner declared gross vehicle weight or combined vehicle gross weight shall be as
13	follows:
14	(1) Less than 30,001 lbs
15	(2) 30,001 to 36,000 lbs
16	(3) 36,001 to 44,000 lbs
17	(4) 44,001 to 54,999 lbs
18	(5) 55,000 to 63,280 lbs
19	(6) 63,281 lbs. to maximum permitted
20	(b) Except as otherwise provided for in this Code section, the annual fee for all
21	apportionable vehicles operated as a common or contract carrier for hire in accordance with
22	owner declared gross vehicle weight or combined vehicle gross weight shall be as follows:
23	(1) Less than 30,001 lbs
24	(2) 30,001 to 36,000 lbs
25	(3) 36,001 to 44,000 lbs

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26	(4) 44,001 to 54,999 lbs	
27	(5) 55,000 to 63,280 lbs	
28	(6) 63,281 lbs. to maximum permitted	
29	(c) In addition to the annual fee for apportionable vehicles listed in subsection (a) or (b)	
30	of this Code section, there shall be an ad valorem fee equal to 50 percent of the annual fee	
31	to be paid with the annual fee and collected by the department as part of the annual fee.	
32	The ad valorem fee shall be applied only to vehicles registered under the International	
33	Registration Plan regardless of their domicile.	
34	(d) The ad valorem fee shall be distributed by the department to the counties where the	
35	vehicles are domiciled if the vehicles are domiciled in Georgia or to the general fund of the	
36	state if the vehicles are not domiciled in Georgia. For the initial year only, the funds	
37	otherwise due to the state shall be used to hold harmless any county which can demonstrate	
38	a loss of ad valorem revenue related to vehicles previously domiciled in its jurisdiction	
39	resulting from this change of law.	
40	(e) No other ad valorem tax may be assessed against apportionable vehicles by the state	
41	or by any county or municipality in the state.	
42	(f) The ad valorem fee collected shall be sufficient to cover any ad valorem fees due for	
43	commercial trailers or semi-trailers, and no additional ad valorem fee shall be due on any	
44	commercial trailer or semi-trailer registered in this state.	
45	(c)(g) For each apportionable motor bus or van-type vehicle the fee is \$3.75 for each 100	
46	pounds or fractional part of 100 pounds factory weight. No motor bus license fee shall	
47	exceed \$875.00.	
48	(d)(h) Trucks transporting logs, pulpwood, or other forest products shall be issued	
49	restricted license plates and the fees shall be as enumerated in Code Section 40-2-151.	
50	$\frac{(e)(i)}{(e)}$ Each school bus operated exclusively in the transportation of pupils and teachers to	
51	and from schools or school activities or in the transportation of the owner and his <u>or her</u>	
52	immediate family shall be issued a restricted license plate for the sum a fee of \$5.00. A bus	
53	owned by a church or owned in common with other churches and used and operated	
54	exclusively for the church in transporting members and patrons to and from church or	
55	church activities, when no part of the proceeds of the operation of the bus inures to the	
56	benefit of any private person, shall be issued a restricted license plate for the sum a fee of	
57	\$5.00 in the same manner as school buses when the bus complies with the laws applicable	
58	to school buses.	
59	(f)(j) A truck or a truck-tractor hauling fertilizer, milk, or crops as defined in paragraph	
60	(7.1) of Code Section 1-3-3 shall be issued a restricted license plate with the fee computed	
61	in accordance with Code Section 40-2-151.	

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- 62 (g)(k) A farm vehicle shall be issued a restricted license plate with the fee computed in accordance with Code Section 40-2-151."
- 64 SECTION 2.
- 65 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 66 without such approval.
- 67 **SECTION 3.**
- 68 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
