## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to damages for conversion of timber, so as to change the penalty for converting
- 3 timber; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 7 damages for conversion of timber, is amended by revising Code Section 51-12-50, relating
- 8 to measure of damages for converted timber, as follows:
- 9 "51-12-50.
- Except as provided in Code Section 51-12-51, where plaintiff recovers for timber cut and
- carried away, the measure of damage:
- 12 (1) Where defendant is a willful trespasser, is <u>three times</u> the full value of the property
- at the time and place of demand or when an action is brought without deduction for his
- or her labor or expense, punitive damages, and the injured party's attorney's fees;
- 15 (2) Where defendant is an unintentional or innocent trespasser or an innocent
- purchaser from such trespasser, is <u>three times</u> the value at the time of conversion less
- the value he <u>or she</u> or his <u>or her</u> vender added to the property <u>and the injured party's</u>
- attorney's fees; and
- 19 (3) Where defendant is a purchaser without notice from a willful trespasser, is the
- value at the time of his <u>or her</u> purchase <u>and the injured party's attorney's fees."</u>

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
