A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the Georgia Department of Transportation to transfer the Intermodal Division to
- 2 the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the key to a bright future for this state depends upon the development of all
- 4 types of modern transportation infrastructure; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) does an outstanding job of
- 6 constructing and maintaining the roads and bridges in this state, and that is and should be its
- 7 primary focus; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Georgia has fallen behind other states in developing other methods of
- 9 transportation, including high speed rail and commuter rail, while concentrating on more
- 10 traditional types of transportation infrastructure; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority (GRTA) has the expertise and
- 12 experience to focus all of its resources on the development of all types of transportation
- 13 alternatives for the people of this state and to maximize our resources to meet the challenges
- of the future.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 16 direct the commissioner of transportation to develop a plan to transfer the Intermodal
- 17 Division from GDOT to GRTA in order to allow a greater focus on the development of
- 18 alternative transportation options for the people of this state.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 20 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the commissioner of transportation and
- 21 the executive director of GRTA.
