#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Jean Strange; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has lost one of its finest and most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Mrs. Jean Strange on December 7, 2009; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Strange was a graduate of Georgia Southern University and dedicated 22  
5 years to the Emanuel County Department of Family and Children Services before retiring  
6 from the agency as director; and
- 7 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to her devoted husband, L.C. "Shot"  
8 Strange, and together they were instrumental in improving the community and uplifting the  
9 lives of others; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Strange was a charter member of the East Georgia College Foundation  
11 Board and served as the group's Director Emeritus; and
- 12 WHEREAS, her leadership and guidance as a trustee were greatly valued on the Greater  
13 Swainsboro Technical College Foundation Board and her tireless efforts and support of  
14 Greater Swainsboro Technical College students were admired and appreciated; and
- 15 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Strange was an active member of First  
16 United Methodist Church in Swainsboro, Georgia; and
- 17 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
18 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
19 her family and friends was admired by others; and

20 WHEREAS, Mrs. Strange was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable  
21 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made  
22 of her life, she made this world a better place in which to live; and

23 WHEREAS, Mrs. Strange will long be remembered for her love of family and friendship,  
24 and this loyal wife, friend, and neighbor will be missed by all who had the great fortune of  
25 knowing her.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
27 join in honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Jean Strange and express their deepest and most  
28 sincere regret at her passing.
