A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Cub Scout Pack 3052; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America, a volunteer organization, was incorporated by
3 Chicago publisher William D. Boyce on February 8, 1910, after learning of the Scouting
4 movement during a visit to London; and
- 5 WHEREAS, this year, the Boys Scouts of America program celebrates 100 years of teaching
6 America's youth patriotism, courage, self-reliance, and kindred values; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Cub Scout Pack 3052 of First Presbyterian Church in Ft. Oglethorpe, Georgia,
8 was organized nine years ago to instill the young men of Ft. Oglethorpe with the moral and
9 ethical principles and the habits, practices, and attitudes that are conducive to good character,
10 citizenship, and health; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Cub Scout Pack 3052 has 37 active members who are committed to upholding
12 the principles of scouting in their everyday lives and stand as shining examples of good
13 citizens to their peers, friends, and neighbors; and

15 time, talents, and energy to challenging the scouts of Pack 3052 to achieve their utmost
16 potential and represent the Boy Scouts of America program with pride; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Pack 3052 is a member of the Cherokee Area Council which is wholeheartedly
18 invested in helping youth succeed by providing the support, friendship, and mentoring
19 necessary to live a happy and fulfilling life; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America is the nation's foremost program of character
21 development and values based leadership training for youth, fostering the philosophy of duty

22 to God, country, and self and a commitment to others through a comprehensive program of
23 responsible fun, outdoor adventure, and service projects; and

24 WHEREAS, the service to others and their community and the dedication to the ideals and
25 goals of the Boy Scouts of America program demonstrated by members of Cub Scout Pack
26 3052 and their Pack Leader are worthy of recognition.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
28 the members of this body recognize Cub Scout Pack 3052 for its wonderful public service
29 and commend its members for striving to be responsible and active citizens.
