## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mrs. Cynthia M.A. Butler-McIntyre, 24th National President  
2 of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Cynthia M.A. Butler-McIntyre has long been recognized for the vital role  
4 that she has played in the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority and her deep personal commitment to  
5 supporting educational, civic, cultural, and community-based programs for young people;

7 WHEREAS, Mrs. Butler-McIntyre earned a bachelor's degree in early childhood education  
8 from Dillard University and a master's degree in educational administration/curriculum and  
9 instruction from the University of New Orleans; and

10 WHEREAS, a dedicated professional educator, Mrs. Butler-McIntyre is employed as the  
11 personnel administrator for the Jefferson Parish Public School System in Harvey, Louisiana,  
12 and has served as a kindergarten teacher, assistant principal, and summer school principal;

14 WHEREAS, she has served as an assistant supervisor of student teaching and field  
15 experiences with the University of New Orleans and as executive director of the summer  
16 tech-prep program at Delgado Community College for high school students as they moved  
17 to postsecondary education; and

18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Butler-McIntyre's leadership has been instrumental to numerous civic,  
19 professional, and religious organizations, including as founding president of the  
20 Algiers-Gretna Branch of the NAACP, secretary of the Louisiana Association of School  
21 Personnel Administrators, parliamentarian and charter member of the Jefferson Alliance of  
22 Black School Educators, and past first vice president of the Coalition of 100 Black Women;

24 WHEREAS, she has been an active member of Delta Sigma Theta since 1973, actively  
25 participating at the local, state, and national levels, and is the co-founder of Momma's Girls,  
26 a ministry for motherless daughters; and

27 WHEREAS, Mrs. Butler-McIntyre has been recognized with numerous honors and  
28 accolades, including a Distinguished Alumnus Award from Dillard University, Louisiana's  
29 Elementary Assistant Principal of the Year, and an Exceptional Service Award from the  
30 American Association of School Personnel Administrators; and

31 WHEREAS, a faithful member of Olive Branch Baptist Church in New Orleans, she is united  
32 in love and marriage to her supportive husband, Ronney, and has been blessed with four  
33 children, Shavonny, Roney, Ciara, and Rachaud, and two grandchildren, Gavon and Angie;

35 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary achievements and  
36 contributions of Mrs. Butler-McIntyre be appropriately recognized.
