14 Open and Buick Challenge Golf Tournaments, past president and active member of the
15 Rotary Club of East Columbus, past board member of PAWS, and current chairman of the
16 board for Community of Hero's; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Bryant was united in love and marriage for 49 wonderful years to his wife
18 Cynthia, and was blessed with the love and support of his family, Dawn and Fred Braswell
19 and Angie and Tim Coleman, eight grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
21 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
22 family and friends were admired by others; and

23 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
24 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
25 made this world a better place in which to live; and

26 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Bryant will long be remembered for
27 his love of family and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, grandfather, uncle, and
28 friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
