A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to employment under the "Quality Basic Education Act"; so as to enact
- 3 the "Salary Protection Act"; to provide for legislative intent; to provide that state funding for
- 4 salaries for school system personnel shall not be diverted to other uses; to provide that
- 5 salaries shall not be subject to proration and that school system personnel shall not be subject
- 6 to furloughs; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Salary Protection Act."

10 SECTION 2.

- 11 The Georgia General Assembly finds that it is in the best interests of students, teachers, local
- school systems, and the education system as a whole to ensure that state appropriations
- designated for salary and benefits for school system personnel are reserved for those specific
- 14 purposes.
- SECTION 3.
- 16 Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 17 relating to employment under the "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended by adding a
- 18 new Code section to read as follows:
- 19 "<u>20-2-212.6.</u>
- 20 (a) No state funds appropriated and allotted for salaries for school system personnel shall
- 21 <u>be transferred by any local board of education to any other purposes.</u>
- 22 (b) In the event of budgetary shortfall, salaries for school system personnel shall not be
- 23 <u>subject to proration and school system personnel shall not be subject to furloughs."</u>
