A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 standards, labeling, and adulteration of food, so as to require retail grocery stores to make
- 3 toilet or washroom facilities available to purchasing customers if such facilities are present
- 4 on the premises; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 6 SECTION 1.
- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to standards,
- 8 labeling, and adulteration of food, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 "26-2-32.1.
- Any retail grocery store that is open to the general public shall, if such establishment has
- 12 <u>toilet or washroom facilities on the premises, make such facilities available to purchasing</u>
- 13 <u>customers for use."</u>
- 14 SECTION 2.
- 15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
