

The House Committee on Regulated Industries offers the following substitute to  
HB 1269:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to prohibited acts relative to alcoholic beverages, so as to define a certain term; to  
3 provide that the sale or purchase of caffeinated alcoholic beverages shall be prohibited in this  
4 state; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
8 prohibited acts relative to alcoholic beverages, is amended by adding a new Code section to  
9 read as follows:

10 "3-3-34.

11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'caffeinated alcoholic beverage' means a  
12 presealed beverage in an individual serving container containing caffeine and at least  
13 one-half of 1 percent of alcohol by volume.

14 (b) No person shall sell, offer for sale, or purchase any caffeinated alcoholic beverage in  
15 this state."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
