1 Recognizing and commending Mrs. Helen Grayson; and for other purposes.

4 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, a native of Fremont, Michigan, Mrs. Grayson graduated from DePauw
6 University and has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and this state; and

8 WHEREAS, she has been a member of the Utility Club of Griffin since 1973, serving as
9 president from 1978-1979, and was recognized as member of the year from 1981-1982; and
