AS PASSED SENATE

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend Code Section 32-6-76 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 restrictions on directional signs, so as to allow the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame Authority
3 to designate signs commemorating significant sporting achievements; to provide for related
4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 32-6-76 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to restrictions on
8 directional signs, is amended by revising paragraph (11) as follows:

9 "(11) Advertises privately owned activities or attractions other than natural phenomena;
10 scenic attractions; historic, educational, cultural, scientific, and religious sites;
11 agricultural tourist attractions designated by the Department of Agriculture; and outdoor
12 recreational areas ~~and~~ which are nationally or regionally known and are of outstanding
13 interest to the traveling public, as determined by the State Transportation Board; and
14 significant sporting achievements, as determined by the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame
15 Authority."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
