A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-6-184 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 impeding the flow of traffic, so as to provide for a minimum fine for impeding traffic flow;
- 3 to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 40-6-184 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to impeding the
- 8 flow of traffic, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 9 "(a)(1) No person shall drive a motor vehicle at such a slow speed as to impede the
- normal and reasonable movement of traffic, except when reduced speed is necessary for
- safe operation.

- 12 (2) On roads, streets, or highways with two or more lanes allowing for movement in the
- same direction, no person shall continue to operate a motor vehicle in the most left-hand
- lane at less than the maximum lawful speed limit once such person knows or should
- reasonably know that he <u>or she</u> is being overtaken in such lane from the rear by a motor
- vehicle traveling at a higher rate of speed, except when such motor vehicle is preparing
- for a left turn. <u>This subsection shall not apply to managed lanes.</u>
- 18 (3) Any conviction for a violation of the provisions of this subsection shall be punishable
- by a minimum fine of \$75.00 in addition to any other punishment authorized by law."

SECTION 2.

- 21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010, and be applicable to any offenses committed
- 22 on or after that date.
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
