A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Warren Levon Matthews; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Mr. Warren Levon Matthews on March 4, 2010; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Matthews was born on May 6, 1924, in Heineman-Williamsburg County,
5 South Carolina, a beloved son of the late Henry and Mable Matthews; and
- 6 WHEREAS, educated in the Williamsburg County public school system, Mr. Matthews lived
7 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for most of his adult life, relocating to the Atlanta area with
8 his daughters in 2005; and
- 9 WHEREAS, affectionately known as "Doc," Mr. Matthews was a resident at Lake City
10 Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Lake City, Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Matthews accepted Jesus Christ as his
12 savior and was baptized on June 17, 1959, at Mt. Sinai Tabernacle Baptist Church in
13 Philadelphia, where he served for many years as a faithful member and served on the food
14 bank ministry and other auxiliaries; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Matthews was united in love and marriage to the late Mary Bluford in
16 1945, and was blessed with four wonderful children, Eugene, Levon, Alice, and Karen; five
17 grandchildren, Natacha, Sabrina, Brian, Khaliah, and Wade; and four great-grandchildren,
18 Joshua, Isaiah, Michael, and Noah; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
20 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
21 family and friends were admired by others; and

22 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
23 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
24 made this world a better place in which to live; and

25 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Matthews will long be remembered
26 for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal father, grandfather, brother, and friend
27 will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
29 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Mr. Warren Levon
