- WHEREAS, during the month of April, Prevent Child Abuse Habersham will conductseveral events in order to raise public awareness of child abuse; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Prevent Child Abuse Habersham sponsors four programs, First Steps, Parents
- 18 as Teachers, Need to Talk, and Stewards of Children, in an effort to prevent child abuse in
- 19 Habersham County before it begins; and
- WHEREAS, the contributions and efforts of Prevent Child Abuse Habersham and othersworking to prevent child abuse are worthy of recognition.
