#### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Makeda Darlene Searson-Ahad; and for other  
2 purposes.

4 with the passing of Mrs. Makeda Darlene Searson-Ahad on February 14, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Searson-Ahad was born as Darlene Searson on January 2, 1958, a beloved  
6 daughter of Leroy Mack Searson and Dorothy Mae McCants; and

8 by Elder Moses Farrar after her calling; and

15 causes, and had a knack for decorating and fashion that was admired by many; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Searson-Ahad was united in love and marriage to Abdullah Ahad in 1991  
17 and was blessed with a remarkable son, Rasun, and a wonderful granddaughter, Rasunek; and

18 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
19 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
20 her family and friends was admired by others; and

21 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
22 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,  
23 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

24 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Mrs. Searson-Ahad will long be  
25 remembered for her love of family and friendship, and this loyal mother, grandmother, aunt,  
26 and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
