- 1 Recognizing and commending Georgia Institute of Technology Football Head Coach Paul
- 2 Johnson on being named the 2009 Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year; and for
- 3 other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, Coach Paul Johnson joined the Georgia Institute of Technology as head coach
- 5 of the Yellow Jacket football team in 2007 after successful coaching runs at Georgia
- 6 Southern University and the United States Naval Academy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in only his second year coaching the Yellow Jackets, he led the team to a 10-2
- 8 regular season with historic wins over Florida State University, Virginia Tech, and Clemson
- 9 University; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Coach Johnson's powerful triple option earned the Yellow Jackets a top ten
- 11 national ranking at the end of the season and the 2009 Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC)
- 12 Championship for the first time since 1990; and
- 13 WHEREAS, modeling Coach Johnson's work ethic and discipline, the team produced the
- 14 ACC Defensive Player of the Year and earned a bid to the FedEx Orange Bowl, a first ever
- 15 Bowl Championship Series appearance for the university; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Atlantic Coast Sports Media Association recognized the outstanding
- 17 leadership of Coach Johnson by naming him the ACC Coach of the Year for the second
- 18 consecutive year, making him the only head coach in Georgia Tech's history to win this
- 19 prestigious award in his first two seasons.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 21 commend Georgia Institute of Technology Football Head Coach Paul Johnson on his
- 22 exceptional accomplishments and achievements and congratulate him on his back-to-back
- 23 Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year awards.
