## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the League of Women Voters of Georgia on the occasion of its 90th  
2 anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters was founded on February 14, 1920, as a  
4 volunteer, nonpartisan organization to promote political responsibility through informed and  
5 active participation of citizens in government; and

6 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Georgia is widely recognized as exerting a  
7 positive influence on government at all levels and as being instrumental in encouraging voter  
8 registration and participation; and

9 WHEREAS, the diligent efforts of the League of Women Voters of Georgia has earned the  
10 organization a well-deserved reputation as one of the most beneficial and influential political  
11 organizations in this state; and

12 WHEREAS, throughout its 90 years, the League has continuously and consistently worked  
13 for responsible and responsive government at the local, state, and national levels; and

14 WHEREAS, the commitment and dedication of the League of Women Voters and its many  
15 members have been amply demonstrated in its 90 years; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of this fine  
17 organization and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be appropriately  
18 recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body commend the League of Women Voters of Georgia for 90 years  
21 of service to the State of Georgia.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
23 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the League of Women  
24 Voters of Georgia.
