A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Stone Mountain-Lithonia Alumnae Chapter of Delta
2 Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., is a public service organization founded on
4 January 13, 1913, by 22 visionary women at Howard University in order to provide services
5 and programs that promote human welfare; and

6 WHEREAS, the founders' vision has crystallized to encompass a sisterhood of more than
7 200,000 predominantly black college educated women, representing over 900 chapters in the
8 United States, England, Japan, Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas, and the
9 Republic of Korea; and

10 WHEREAS, the Stone Mountain-Lithonia Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority,
11 Inc., was chartered on March 9, 1997, in Stone Mountain, Georgia; and

12 WHEREAS, since its chartering, the Stone Mountain-Lithonia Alumnae Chapter has
13 implemented a variety of programs and services that positively impact its community under
14 the Sorority's Five Point Program Thrust: Economic Development, Educational
15 Development, International Awareness and Involvement, Physical and Mental Health, and
16 Political Awareness and Involvement; and

17 WHEREAS, the Stone Mountain-Lithonia Alumnae Chapter is celebrating its 11th annual
18 Debutante Cotillion in Atlanta, Georgia, on March 27, 2010, by introducing academically,
19 socially, and culturally prepared young ladies into society; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of this fine
21 organization and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be appropriately
22 recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend the Stone Mountain-Lithonia Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority,
25 Inc., on its many accomplishments and recognize the exemplary service its members provide
26 to their communities and this state.
