A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the Georgia Building Authority to provide additional parking for disabled persons
2 visiting the Georgia capitol building; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia capitol building is a unique national and state treasure; and

4 WHEREAS, all of the citizens of Georgia deserve the opportunity to visit the capitol and
5 enjoy the treasures held within the building; and

6 WHEREAS, due to the limited parking spaces around the capitol building it is often difficult
7 to find a place to park nearby; and

8 WHEREAS, this can cause particular problems for disabled persons desiring to visit the
9 capitol building; and

10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Building Authority has the authority to reserve more of the parking
11 spaces around the capitol building for disabled persons.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
13 the members of this body urge the Georgia Building Authority to reserve more of the parking
14 spaces around the capitol building for use by disabled persons.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
16 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the executive director of the
17 Georgia Building Authority.
