## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Georgia's African American Horse Council Community  
2 Advocate Cowgirl, Ms. Yvonne Edwards; and for other purposes.

4 conscientiously devote their time, talents, and energy to giving back to their community  
5 through education programs and community service efforts; and

6 WHEREAS, Ms. Yvonne Edwards has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for  
7 the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the  
8 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, a native of Cleveland, Ohio, Ms. Edwards has been working with horses since  
10 she was three and is committed to improving Georgia communities one horseback ride at a

18 horses are not to be feared and instills a respect for horses in others; and

19 WHEREAS, passionate about her sport, Ms. Edwards is proud to be part of the African  
20 American cowgirl legacy and enjoys seeing children in her community gain self-confidence  
21 through their interaction with animals; and

22 WHEREAS, Ms. Edwards is a kindhearted and magnanimous cowgirl who brings great pride  
23 to her family, neighbors, and community; and

24 WHEREAS, the benevolent and honorable deeds of this charitable individual serve as a  
25 shining example of volunteerism, and the State of Georgia is honored and blessed to have  
26 Ms. Edwards as a citizen.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
28 the members of this body commend Ms. Yvonne Edwards on her selfless contributions to
