

House Bill 1080 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of utilities commissioners for Catoosa County, approved  
2 March 17, 1956 (Ga. L. 1956, p. 3499), as amended, so as to provide for a certain time period  
3 for qualifying for election to such board; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting  
4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating a board of utilities commissioners for Catoosa County, approved March 17,  
8 1956 (Ga. L. 1956, p. 3499), as amended, is amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection  
9 (b) of Section 1 to read as follows:

10 "(3) The authority shall hold a meeting on the first Tuesday in October of the year  
11 preceding the year in which any member's term is ended for the purpose of electing a  
12 successor. The authority shall cause a public notice of the date, time, and place of such  
13 meeting to be published in the legal organ of Catoosa County once during the first week  
14 in September. Any person who is otherwise qualified to serve as a member of the  
15 authority may qualify for election by filing a written notice of candidacy, together with  
16 proof that such person is a consumer of authority services, during normal business hours  
17 from September 1 through September 8 preceding the meeting at which the election is  
18 held. Only those persons who submit a written notice of candidacy shall be eligible for  
19 election at such meeting."
