## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act providing that the judge of the Probate Court of Union County shall serve
- 2 as chief magistrate of the Magistrate Court of Union County, approved February 25, 1997
- 3 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 3504), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 9, 1999 (Ga. L.
- 4 1999, p. 3799), so as to provide that the probate judge of Union County shall be elected on
- 5 a nonpartisan basis; to provided for related matters; to provide for submission of this Act
- 6 under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to repeal conflicting
- 7 laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 An Act providing that the judge of the Probate Court of Union County shall serve as chief
- 11 magistrate of the Magistrate Court of Union County, approved February 25, 1997 (Ga. L.
- 12 1997, p. 3504), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 9, 1999 (Ga. L. 1999, p.
- 13 3799), is amended by revising subsection (a) of Section (1) as follows:
- 14 "(a) The chief magistrate of Union County shall continue to serve as such until the
- expiration of his or her term on December 31, 2012. Beginning at the general election of
- 16 2012, a successor chief magistrate shall be elected by the voters of Union County. At such
- 17 election and at every election thereafter, the chief magistrate shall be elected on a
- nonpartisan basis. The chief magistrate shall serve for a term of four years."
- 19 **SECTION 2.**
- 20 The governing authority of Union County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to be
- 21 submitted for preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
- amended; and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or
- 23 filed with the appropriate court no later than 60 days after the date on which this Act is
- 24 approved by the Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.
