

The Senate Health and Human Services Committee offered the following substitute to HB 1179:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 31-7-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 influenza vaccinations for discharged patients aged 65 and older, vaccinations or other
3 measures for health care workers in hospitals, immunity from liability, and standing orders,
4 so as to require hospitals to annually offer influenza vaccinations to its health care workers
5 and other employees; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Code Section 31-7-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to influenza
9 vaccinations for discharged patients aged 65 and older, vaccinations or other measures for
10 health care workers in hospitals, immunity from liability, and standing orders, is amended
11 by revising subsection (b) as follows:

13 "(b) A hospital ~~may offer~~ shall annually offer to its health care workers and other
14 employees who have direct contact with patients, at no cost, vaccinations for the influenza
15 virus in accordance with the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and
16 Prevention, subject to availability of the vaccine. A hospital may offer to its health care
17 workers and other employees any other vaccination, test, or prophylactic measure required
18 or recommended by, and in accordance with, the recommendations of, the Centers for
19 Disease Control and Prevention. All such vaccinations, tests, or prophylactic measures
20 may be offered or administered pursuant to standing orders approved by the hospital's
21 medical staff to ensure the safety of employees, patients, visitors, and contractors."

SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
