A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ms. Linda DiSantis for her dedicated support of women and
2 families; and for other purposes.

4 vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the needs
5 of women and families; and

6 WHEREAS, Ms. DiSantis has been recognized with the Linda T. Muir Award for Business
7 and Law from the Georgia Women's Institute for her diligent and conscientious service; and

8 WHEREAS, the mission of the Georgia Women's Institute is to bring together women to
9 endorse and support women's leadership and educational programs, develop and disseminate
10 research, secure funds to support core issues for women and families in Georgia, and provide
11 information, training, and advocacy; and

12 WHEREAS, the Georgia Women's Institute focuses on issues such as health and wellness,
13 violence, education, employment, economic opportunities, discrimination in all its forms,
14 sexual harassment, social issues, and honoring accomplishments of Georgia women; and

16 Nellie Dunaway Duke, Linda Torrence, Mary Lou Frank, and Linda T. Muir; and

17 WHEREAS, Ms. DiSantis's selfless service to the women and families of Georgia serves as
18 a shining example of volunteerism and her leadership and vision inspire her community,
19 colleagues, and peers; and

20 WHEREAS, the citizens of Georgia owe a tremendous debt of gratitude to Ms. DiSantis and
21 the Georgia Women's Institute and its members for their many contributions to their
22 communities and the positive role models they represent for women of all ages; and

23 WHEREAS, Ms. DiSantis continually demonstrates tireless and unyielding advocacy for
24 issues affecting women and children and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the
25 extraordinary accomplishments of this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
