

Senate Resolution 1372

#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Ralph Easterwood of Glen Haven Baptist Church  
2 on the occasion of his retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Reverend Ralph Easterwood joined Glen Haven Baptist Church with his family  
4 when he was 12 years old in 1947, the church's first year, and was baptized the following  
5 year; and

6 WHEREAS, he devoted his service to Glen Haven Baptist Church in various areas for many  
7 years before he was selected as senior pastor in 1983, including service as leader of the youth  
8 group, an ordained deacon, and associate pastor; and

9 WHEREAS, in 2002, Reverend Easterwood moved the church along with its 268 members  
10 from Decatur to McDonough, and membership has increased to over 1,000 since the move  
11 to Henry County; and

12 WHEREAS, this faithful man of God held annual Jubilee revival services for 27 years with  
13 over 1,000 in attendance nightly to enjoy great singing and preaching of the Word; and

14 WHEREAS, Reverend Easterwood has established the faith promise mission program,  
15 Remain Faithful So the Faithful May Remain, and other mission programs which have  
16 annual support of over \$300,000 toward worldwide missions; and

17 WHEREAS, whether the task is preparing a sermon, visiting the sick, counseling the  
18 troubled, baptizing a new believer, or acting as a theologian, educator, administrator, or  
19 humanitarian, Reverend Easterwood serves as a shining example of God's righteous path; and

20 WHEREAS, Reverend Easterwood is united in love and marriage to his wife, Gwen, who  
21 has faithfully served the members of Glen Haven Baptist Church in the office for 40 years,

22 and they have been blessed with five children and several grandchildren and  
23 great-grandchildren; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message  
25 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for his innumerable good works rendered  
26 on behalf of persons in need.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
28 recognize Reverend Ralph Easterwood's 43 years of outstanding fellowship and leadership  
29 at Glen Haven Baptist Church and extend to him best wishes on a healthy and happy  
30 retirement.
