The Senate Health and Human Services Committee offered the following substitute to HB 1021:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- possession of dangerous drugs, by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
 "(4.3) Possession, planting, cultivation, growing, or harvesting of Salvia divinorum or
 Salvia divinorum A strictly for aesthetic, landscaping, or decorative purposes;"
