- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body urge the Georgia Department of Community Health to work with representatives from the Georgia Municipal Association, the Medical Association of Georgia, the Georgia Pharmacy Association, the Home Health Care Association of Georgia, the American Diabetes Association, the Georgia Hospitality Association, the Georgia Restaurant Association, and the National Solid Waste Management Association in creating this important education program.
