A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Marcus J. Gibson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Marcus J. Gibson has demonstrated his commitment to teaching the
3 Gospel, witnessing Christ through word and deed, and addressing the physical,
4 psychological, intellectual, and spiritual needs of others; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Reverend Gibson was born in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, on May 22, 1971, the
6 beloved eldest child of Samuel, Jr., and Sadie Diane Childress Gibson; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Arkansas Pine Bluff and
8 a master's degree from the Interdenominational Theological Center; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Reverend Gibson served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with
10 the United States Army as a first lieutenant; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was called by the Lord to teach and preach the Gospel in 1992 and was
12 ordained as a Baptist preacher in 1994; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Reverend Gibson has served as pastor of Greater Shady Grove Missionary
14 Baptist Church in Columbus, Georgia, since 1998, and before leading the church
15 congregation, he served as a Sunday school teacher, youth superintendent, Inspiration Choir
16 member, pulpit associate, Sunday school lesson reviewer, member of the Usher Board, and
17 member of the Christian Education Ministry; and
- 18 WHEREAS, his vision and direction have helped Greater Shady Grove Missionary Baptist
19 Church grow in size and influence, uplifting the community like the light of Bethlehem and
20 serving as a spiritual leader and place for fellowship; and

21 WHEREAS, Reverend Gibson is united in love and marriage to Ulander Shir'e Bratton
22 Gibson, and they have been blessed with two remarkable children, MarDarius and MarKayla;

24 WHEREAS, whether the task is preparing a sermon, visiting the sick, counseling the
25 troubled, baptizing a new believer, or acting as a theologian, educator, administrator, or
26 humanitarian, Reverend Gibson serves as a shining example of God's righteous path; and

27 WHEREAS, the unmatched spiritual assistance offered by Reverend Gibson is a source of
28 strength and direction for persons in all walks of life and from all economic strata; and

29 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
30 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for his innumerable good works rendered
31 on behalf of persons in need.
