A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Chattahoochee United Methodist Church on the occasion of
2 its 150th anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the seeds which were sown in Robertstown, Georgia, by the loving and humble
4 efforts of the devoted original worshipers of Chattahoochee United Methodist Church and
5 its original pastor Reverend L.G. Norton have blossomed, establishing a rich tradition and
6 history; and

7 WHEREAS, established on May 18, 1860, when John Trammel deeded three acres of land
8 on a rise above the west bank of the Chattahoochee River north of Robertstown,
9 Chattahoochee United Methodist Church's original trustees included Reverend John T.
10 Richardson, H.H. Conley, Benjamin Allison, Charles L. Williams, Jerome England, James
11 Gregory, and John Trammel; and

12 WHEREAS, this amazing place of worship has grown under the divine direction of
13 numerous pastors over the years, allowing the Word of God to spread throughout the
14 community; and

15 WHEREAS, the congregation of this church has compiled an unparalleled record of
16 constructive, compassionate, and humanitarian service which it demonstrates daily through
17 open minds, open hearts, and open doors; and

18 WHEREAS, members of Chattahoochee United Methodist Church have a sincere desire to
19 serve the Lord and are wholeheartedly committed to spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ; and

20 WHEREAS, this momentous occasion is to be celebrated on May 23, 2010, with
21 Homecoming festivities to include an old fashioned lunch and distinguished speakers
22 representing the past, present, and future of the Church; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
24 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for its innumerable good works rendered
25 on behalf of persons in need.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 recognize the rich history of Chattahoochee United Methodist Church, commend its 150
28 years of dedicated service to the Lord and community, and extend their warmest best wishes
29 for its continued growth and success.
