1 Urging the Georgia Department of Transportation to prioritize a certain project; and for other

- WHEREAS, in these uncertain economic times all of the resources devoted to improving

5 WHEREAS, SR 20 is an important state highway that needs to be upgraded in order to 6 maximize economic development along its corridor; and

WHEREAS, another compelling reason to prioritize the upgrade of SR 20 is to protect the
safety of the motorists who use it on a daily basis; and

9 WHEREAS, the benefits of prioritizing the upgrade of this strategic regional project would 10 not only spread to the people of the area, but to the entire state, as it would intertwine 11 seamlessly with the Georgia Department of Transportation's goal of a developing a 12 state-wide transportation network.
