A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mr. A. Christopher Borders; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. A. Christopher Borders has long been recognized by the citizens of this
3 state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to
4 the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, a native of Perry, Georgia, Mr. Borders earned a bachelor's degree in political
6 science from Mercer University and graduated from the Hotel/Restaurant Department and
7 Business School at Florida State University; and

8 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
9 States Army Infantry, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during the
10 Vietnam War; and

11 WHEREAS, he has been a certified Club Manager with the Club Managers' Association of
12 America since 1982 and has diligently and conscientiously devoted his expertise, time,
13 talents, and energy to clubs in the Atlanta area; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Borders began his career with the Atlanta Athletic Club in Duluth as an
15 assistant manager in 1975 and, after a three year term as general manager of Horseshoe Bend
16 Country Club in Roswell, he returned to the Atlanta Athletic Club as general manager in
17 1989, where he has provided excellent leadership and service ever since; and

18 WHEREAS, he has been recognized with numerous honors and accolades during his
19 prestigious career, including Club Manager of the Year in 1992 from Club Managers'
20 Association of America and 2005 Golf Operator of the Year by *Golf, Inc.*; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Borders is chairman of the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame nominating
22 committee and is a past president of the Florida State University Society of Hosts; and

23 WHEREAS, a resident of Cherokee County, Mr. Borders has been united in love and
24 marriage to his wife Patricia for 40 wonderful years and enjoys golf, fly fishing, and reading;

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
27 this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
