A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To authorize the City of Doraville to exercise all redevelopment and other powers under

2 Article IX, Section II, Paragraph VII of the Constitution and Chapter 44 of Title 36 of the

3 O.C.G.A., the "Redevelopment Powers Law," as amended; to provide for a referendum; to

4 provide effective dates; to provide for automatic repeal under certain circumstances; to repeal

5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 The City of Doraville shall be and is authorized to exercise all redevelopment and other powers under Chapter 44 of Title 36 of the O.C.G.A., the "Redevelopment Powers Law," as 9 10 amended. The intention of this Act is to authorize the City of Doraville to undertake and 11 carry out community redevelopment, to create tax allocation districts, to issue tax allocation 12 bonds, and to incur other obligations within the meaning of and as fully permitted under the provisions of Article IX, Section II, Paragraph VII of the Constitution of the State of Georgia 13 14 of 1983, as amended, and to authorize the City of Doraville to exercise redevelopment 15 powers as fully as the "Redevelopment Powers Law" may now or hereafter permit and not to limit any redevelopment powers permitted under the "Redevelopment Powers Law." 16

SECTION 2.

Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the election superintendent of the City of Doraville shall call and conduct a special election as provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the City of Doraville for approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct that election on the date of the general election in November of 2010 and shall issue the call and conduct that election as provided by general law. The election superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date 10

thereof in the official organ of DeKalb County. The ballot shall have written or printedthereon the words:

"() YES Shall the Act be approved which authorizes the City of Doraville to exercise
redevelopment powers under the 'Redevelopment Powers Law,' as it may
() NO be amended from time to time?"

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring 30 to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on 31 such question are for approval of the Act, then Section 1 of this Act shall become of full 32 force and effect immediately. If Section 1 of this Act is not so approved or if the election is 33 34 not conducted as provided in this section, Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective and this Act shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January following such 35 election date. The expense of such election shall be borne by the City of Doraville. It shall 36 be the municipal election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the Secretary 37 38 of State.

SECTION 3.

40 Except as otherwise provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall become effective on41 January 1, 2011.

SECTION 4.

43 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
