A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Daniel Lewis Mallory; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Daniel Lewis Mallory has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
8 Daniel has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills
9 taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 467 and has demonstrated
11 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, Daniel transformed a vacant and overgrown lot
14 in the Club Forest neighborhood of Brookhaven into a mini park with a walking path, bench
15 swing, and birdhouses; and
- 16 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Daniel has truly exhibited a commitment to the
17 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
18 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in 2008, Daniels backpacked 54 miles in three days at Boy Scout Camp Daniel
20 Boone as part of one of only three scout groups in the camp's history to accomplish such a
21 highly vertical trek in just three days; and

22 WHEREAS, he established a Boy Scouts World Milestone in 2009 when he and nine other
23 scouts backpacked 100 miles in five days on the Bartram Trail, reaching an elevation of
24 15,000 feet; and

25 WHEREAS, Daniel participated in a 100-mile hike to raise money for a needy scout family
26 fund, personally raising \$1,100.00 to be added to the group's several thousand dollars; and

27 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
28 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body commend Daniel Lewis Mallory for his diligence and dedication
31 in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him
32 on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
