- 15 WHEREAS, a son of proud parents Richard and Debra Adams, Nick has held numerous
16 leadership positions during his years with the Boy Scouts, including Quartermaster, Den
17 Chief, Assistant Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, and Troop Guide; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Nick has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
19 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
20 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

21 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
22 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend Nicholas Anthony Adams for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
