# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 2 of Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the "State Properties Code," is amended by modifying certain provisions relating to acquiring real property through commission and procedures and funds for such acquisitions; to authorize the State Properties Commission to accept deeds containing reversions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

#### **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 2 of Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
9 "State Properties Code," is amended in Code Section 50-16-38, relating to all state entities
10 acquiring real property through the state properties commission, exceptions, procedure for

11 handling acquisition requests, and funds for acquisitions, as follows:

12 "50-16-38.

13 (a) Except for:

(1) all <u>All</u> acquisitions of real property by the Department of Transportation and the
 Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, and except for;

(2) the <u>The</u> Department of Natural Resources acquiring by gift parcels of real property,
 not exceeding three acres each, to be used for the construction and operation thereon of
 boat-launching ramps, and except for;

(3) acquisitions <u>Acquisitions</u> of real property by the Technical College System of
Georgia in connection with student live work projects funded through moneys generated
as a result of the sale of such projects, donations, or student supply fees, and except for;
(4) acquisitions <u>Aquisitions</u> of real property by the commission resulting from transfers
of custody and control of real property to the commission by executive order of the
Governor or by Act or resolution of the General Assembly, and except as;
(5) Aquisitions of real property by authorities or similar instrumentalities of the state

26 unless otherwise required by law to have approval of the commission; and

27 (6) Acquisitions otherwise provided for by law, and except as otherwise or required by

the nature of the transaction conveying real property to the state or any entity thereof:

29 (1) All state entities shall acquire real property through the commission; and

30 (2) The the title to all real property acquired shall be in the name of the state, except for
 31 state authorities which shall hold title in their own name. The conveyance shall have
 32 written or printed in the upper right-hand corner of the initial page thereof the name of the
 33 state entity for which acquired who is the custodian thereof.

(b) The commission is authorized to establish, and amend when the commission deems it
 necessary, a procedure to facilitate the handling by the commission of requests for
 acquisition of real property.

37 (c) The state entity requesting acquisition of real property shall provide all of the funds38 necessary to acquire the real property.

39 (d) The commission is authorized to accept a donation or conveyance for nominal

40 <u>consideration of real property from a local governing authority with a reversionary interest</u>

41 <u>therein, provided that the donation or conveyance shall only be accepted on the condition</u>

42 <u>that such real property shall not revert while the property is being used for a public purpose</u>

43 <u>as determined by the commission</u>. This subsection shall not be construed as repealing any

- 44 provisions of Code Section 12-6-9 or 35-2-41.
- 45 (e) Upon reversion of the state's interest in real property or a determination by the State

46 <u>Attorney General that the state no longer has an interest in real property, the commission</u>

- 47 <u>is authorized to execute an appropriate instrument of conveyance to clear the record title.</u>
- 48 <u>The commission shall not convey any interest in real property out of this state and any</u>
- 49 instrument purporting to make an out of state conveyance shall be null and void."

## **SECTION 2.**

51 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
