The House Committee on Economic Development and Tourism offers the following substitute to SB 449:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 2 relating to public authorities, so as to repeal provisions relating to the Georgia Golf Hall of 3 Fame Authority; to amend Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia 4 Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to the Department of Economic Development, so as to provide for the disposition of the assets of the Georgia Golf Hall of 5 Fame; to amend Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 50, relating to halls of fame, so as to repeal 6 7 provisions relating to the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame; to provide for authorization to sell real property owned or controlled by the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame; to provide an effective date; 8 9 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.
Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

13 public authorities, is amended by repealing in its entirety Part 13, relating to the Georgia Golf

14 Hall of Fame Authority.

SECTION 2.

Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating togeneral provisions relative to the Department of Economic Development, is amended by

18 adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- 20 The department shall receive all assets, excluding all real property and statues, of the
 21 Georgia Golf Hall of Fame Authority and the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame Board. The
 22 department shall be responsible for any contracts, leases, agreements, or other obligations

23 of such board and authority. The department is substituted as a party to any contract,

- 24 <u>agreement, lease, or other obligation and is responsible for performance as if it had been</u>
- 25 the original party and is entitled to all benefits and rights of enforcement by any other

- 31 Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 50, relating to halls of fame, is amended by repealing and
- 32 reserving Part 2, relating to the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame.

SECTION 4. 33 34 The state, acting by and through its State Properties Commission, shall be authorized to sell 35 by competitive bid all real property owned or controlled by the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame or its authority or board for a consideration of not less than the fair market value as 36 37 determined by the State Properties Commission and not less than the amount of the outstanding bond indebtedness associated with the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame. Such sale 38 shall be as provided in Code Section 50-16-39. Such authorization shall expire three years 39 40 after the effective date of this Act. 41 **SECTION 5.**

- 42 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law43 without such approval.

45 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
