

WITHDRAWN

Senators Douglas of the 17th, Wiles of the 37th, Staton of the 18th, Chapman of the 3rd, Crosby of the 13th and others offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend HB 1002 by inserting on line 2, following "so as", the following:*

2 to change the punishment when the victim is a judge, peace officer, corrections employee,
3 firefighter, or emergency medical technician while engaged in the performance of his or her
4 official duties;

5 *By inserting following line 11 the following:*

6 amended in Code Section 16-5-1, relating to murder and felony murder, by revising
7 subsection (d) as follows:

8 "(d)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a person convicted of
9 the offense of murder shall be punished by death or by imprisonment for life.

10 (2) A person convicted of the offense of murder committed against any judge, peace
11 officer, corrections employee, firefighter, or emergency medical technician while
12 engaged in the performance of his or her official duties shall be punished by death or by
13 imprisonment for life without parole."
