## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Senator Nancy Schaefer; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
- 3 with the passing of Senator Nancy Schaefer on March 26, 2010; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Senator Schaefer diligently and conscientiously devoted her time, talents, and
- 5 energy representing the citizens of District 50 as a member of the Georgia Senate for two
- 6 terms; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a native of Rabun County, Georgia, Senator Schaefer was the president and
- 8 founder of Family Concerns, Inc., a Georgia nonprofit organization she created in 1986 to
- 9 strengthen and protect families through local, state, national, and international policy and
- 10 through the education of citizens and leaders on the vital importance of obeying God's moral
- 11 law; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Senator Schaefer was the founder and president of Family Concerns Pregnancy
- 13 Center, which met the needs of over 5,000 girls and women in the Atlanta area; and
- 14 WHEREAS, a conservative political activist, Senator Schaefer hosted several radio shows
- 15 in the Atlanta area and served as the author of daily commentaries for WRAF, WEPC, and
- 16 WTOH in Toccoa, Georgia; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Senator Schaefer was an eight-year trustee of the National Ethics and Religions
- 18 Liberty Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention and was the former vice president
- 19 of the Georgia Baptist Convention; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Senator Schaefer was united in love and marriage to Bruce Schaefer and was
- 21 blessed with five remarkable children and 13 wonderful grandchildren; and

22 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
23 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
24 her family and friends were admired by others; and

25 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
26 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,  
27 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

28 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Senator Schaefer will long be  
29 remembered for her love of family and friendship, and this loyal mother, grandmother, and  
30 friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
32 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Senator Nancy Schaefer  
33 and express their deepest and most sincere regret at her passing.
