8 energy to Glynn County as Coroner for 16 years and as a magistrate judge for two years; and

11 current member of the Glynn County Supper Club, the Wednesday Night Supper Club of

17 Exalted Ruler three times and Grand Exalted Ruler District Deputy of the Southeast for the

20 Day for ten years, providing entertainment and fun for families with mules and wagons from  
21 far away as Tennessee; and
