A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Cheryl R. Collins; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Cheryl L. Collins has demonstrated her commitment to teaching the
3 Gospel, witnessing Christ through word and deed, and addressing the physical,
4 psychological, intellectual, and spiritual needs of others; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Reverend Collins served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with
6 the United States Army where she was awarded the Bronze Star Medal of Valor for her

9 Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, Georgia; and

14 with numerous honors and awards, including the Servant of the Year Award; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she was called upon by the Commanding General of the United States Army
16 to escort prisoners of war home from the Gulf War; and
- 17 WHEREAS, whether the task is preparing a sermon, visiting the sick, counseling the
18 troubled, baptizing a new believer, or acting as a theologian, educator, administrator, or
19 humanitarian, Reverend Collins serves as a shining example of God's righteous path; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the unmatched spiritual assistance offered by Reverend Collins is a source of
21 strength and direction for persons in all walks of life and from all economic strata; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
23 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for her innumerable good works rendered
24 on behalf of persons in need.
