

House Bill 579 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 43-41-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 eligibility for licensure without examination, reciprocity, and burden upon applicant relative  
3 to residential and general contractors, so as to provide for continuing eligibility for licensure  
4 without examination under certain circumstances; to provide for related matters; to repeal  
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 43-41-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to eligibility for  
9 licensure without examination, reciprocity, and burden upon applicant relative to residential  
10 and general contractors, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

11 "(c) Any business organization that had an applicant submit a complete and satisfactory  
12 application pursuant to this Code section, but was not issued a license due to the death of  
13 the qualifying agent applicant prior to the issuance of the license, shall remain eligible for  
14 consideration under this Code section with the submission of a new qualifying agent  
15 applicant for such business entity."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
