

ADOPTED

Senators Balfour of the 9th and Wiles of the 37th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the committee substitute to HB 858 (LC 38 1149S) by striking the words "for certain*
 2 *judges" on lines 3 and 4 and inserting "and purchases for certain judges and courts".*

3 *By striking the quotation mark on line 15 and all of line 14 and inserting:*

4 *by revising subsections (a) and (b) as follows:*

5 *"(a) The money paid into the hands of the treasurer of the board of trustees of the county*
 6 *law library shall be used for the purchase of law books, reports, texts, periodicals, supplies,*
 7 *desks, and equipment and for the maintenance, upkeep, and operation of the law library,*
 8 *including the services of a librarian and, within the discretion of the board of trustees,*
 9 *payment for purchases made by a county's superior court, state court, probate court,*
 10 *magistrate court, or juvenile court, and for the purchase or leasing of computer related legal*
 11 *research equipment and programs, and, at the discretion of the county governing authority,*
 12 *for the establishment and maintenance of the codification of county ordinances. However,*
 13 *the amount transferred to the county governing authority for codification pursuant to this*
 14 *subsection shall not exceed the cost of establishing or maintaining the codification.*

15 *By inserting after the period on line 22: "Additionally, the probate judge, chief magistrate,*
 16 *presiding juvenile court judge, or any chief judge of any county court may make a similar*
 17 *request."*

18 *By striking Section 3 and inserting:*

SECTION 3.

20 (a) Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012, the same date on which the
 21 United States decennial census of 2010 shall become effective for purposes of Code Section
 22 36-15-11.

23 (b) The remaining sections of this Act shall become effective upon its approval by the
 24 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
