16 at Valdosta State University, including a GPCA Best News Article Based on Investigative
17 Reporting, a Most Improved Senator Award from the Student Government Association, and
18 a Most Potential Reporter from *The Spectator*; and

20 pursue a career in broadcast or print journalism; and

21 WHEREAS, Ms. Everson has brought great pride to her family, friends, and community, and
22 the State of Georgia looks forward with eager anticipation to the promising future of this
